ORDER

Under Article 235 read with Article 241-A of Punjab Education Code, the provisional recognition is granted from 01.04.2022 to 31.3.2026 to Bhartiya Vidya Bhavans School, Sector-27B, subject to the following terms and conditions -

1. This provisional recognition is granted subject to the condition that documents/ information furnished by the Managing Committee on behalf of the school and Allottee of the land i.e. Bhartiya Vidya Bhavan, Bombay, Chandigarh Kendra, DAV College, Sector-10, Chandigarh (Allottee) is correct and not devoid of truth in any way. However, if any information at any stage is found contrary the provisional recognition would be revoked forthwith.
2. The Allottee shall be bound by any undertaking/letters/submission to the Department by the Managing Committee/School. The Allottee hereby undertakes to indemnify the Chandigarh Administration/Department of Education for all acts & omissions of the Managing Committee/ School. The school will not be transferred to a different Managing Body already approved by the Department.
3. Provisions of RTE Act related to admission of students under EWS category and disadvantages groups be followed in letter and spirit (wherever applicable).
4. The Managing Committee and any changes to it should get approval from the Department.
5. The Managing Committee/School shall follow in letter and spirit the provisions of Punjab Education Code (as applicable to UT Chandigarh), the Punjab Regulation of fee of Un-aided Educational Institutions Act, 2016 (as applicable to UT Chandigarh) and any other applicable act/rule. No particular book shop be prescribed for purchase of book/uniform etc. by the school and Instructions/guidelines issued by CBSE relating to books/uniforms are to be followed. The Managing Committee shall be liable for disciplinary action in case of violation of any provisions of the Code/Act/Rules/Directions.
6. The Managing Committee will follow its land allotment conditions and other notifications/orders/instructions issued by the Chandigarh Administration/Department of Education, UT Chandigarh from time to time.
7. Salary be paid to the teachers and other staff strictly as per provision of Appendix-I of CBSE Affiliation by Laws/ norms which should be at par with the teachers working in Govt. School in U.T., Chandigarh.
8. The Managing Committee/School will recruit teachers as per NCTE notification dated 12.11.2014 (as amended from time to time) regarding minimum qualification.
9. The School shall follow the course of study as per syllabus prescribed by the affiliated board.
10. The Managing Committee/School will not add any class/section and/or shall not close down the school or and existing class during the academic session without the prior permission of the Chandigarh Administration/Department of Education, UT Chandigarh.
11. The Reserve Fund is to be pledged in the name of DEO, U.T., Chandigarh as per rule. Shortage of Reserve Fund should be completed within six months.
12. Instructions/guidelines issued by the Central Board of Secondary Education shall be followed.
13. The applicable Building and Fire Safety norms be followed meticulously and there should be no laxity in this regard. Fire Safety Certificates from Municipal Corporation should be obtained before the start of school i.e. July, 2023.
14. Fee should be charged from the students as per CBSE Affiliation Bye Laws 2018 (as amended from time to time) and the Punjab Regulation of fee of Un-aided Educational Institutions Act, 2016 (as applicable to UT Chandigarh) as amended from time.
15. The School shall be open for inspection to the inspecting officer authorized by the Chandigarh Administration/Department of Education, UT Chandigarh.
16. Recognition is liable to be withdrawn if the management or the staff of the school take part in agitation against the authority of Government, or disseminate opinions tending to excite feelings of disloyalty or disaffection against Government or of enmity and hatred between different classes or if the pupils are permitted to attend political meetings or to engage in any form of political or communal agitation.
17. Chandigarh Administration/Department of Education, UT Chandigarh reserves the right, to grant, refuse or withdraw recognition at its entire discretion.
18. Admission of 25% EWS students and Disadvantaged group be made upto class 8<sup>th</sup> under RTE Act, 2009 and admission of 15% EWS students from class 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> be made as per land allotment obligatory clause/s of allotment letter (provisions of Capital of Punjab (Dev. & Reg.) Act, 1952.
19. The Contract of service between management and staff be followed.
20. School busses have proper driver with valid license, fitness certificate of vehicles, fire extinguisher, speed control device, CCTV cameras and other requirements as per STA instructions.
