





c) **Shapes** - Make a grapes impression using any <u>"CIRCLE"</u> shaped object.






AND- Make a Rainbow using <u>"SEMI-CIRCLE" shape pattern sheets.</u>

pictures of your family members.




e) Body parts - Make the child learn the body parts and paste the cut-outs of the items we use for the cleanliness of our body parts.
